By this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a direction to the official respondents no.2 to 4 to add Section 3(i)(s) and 3(2)(v) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, in FIR No.155, dated 19.04.2022, registered at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 148/149/323/506 of the IPC. He also seeks protection of his life and liberty as also that of his family members.

It is seen that in respect of his grievance the petitioner has made a representation to the SP, Karnal, dated 19.04.2022 (copy Annexure P-2).

Consequently, without making any comment on the actual merits of what is contended in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the SP, Karnal, to hear the petitioner and to take a decision on his representation, within a period of

one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It is to be noticed that on an advance copy of the petition having been received by the learned State counsel, he has taken instructions that even the report under Section 173(2) of the Cr.P.C. has been submitted to the competent court.

Naturally, the petitioner would also be at liberty to take his remedies before that court; but in any case if the SP also finds any substance at all in what the petitioner has contended, obviously he would consider whether or not any further proceedings by the investigating agency need to be taken.
