RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the award dated 31.07.2012 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.1, awarding compensation of Rs.35000/- w.e.f. 08.11.1998 till July, 2012, Rs.5000/- as wages for one month along with interest @ 9% from 8.11.1998 till upto date and other benefits.

During the course of arguments, the counsel for the respondent-workman had expressed a desire that if the petitioner-employer pays an amount of Rs.75,000/- more; over and above; the amount already deposited with this Court, the matter can be finally settled.

The counsel for the petitioner-employer has brought the demand draft No.531046 dated 18.11.2022 amounting to Rs.75,000/ in the name of respondent-workman. The said demand draft has been handed over

to the counsel for the respondent-workman. Photocopy of the same is taken on record. Therefore, the matter stands settled between the parties.

Accordingly, the award passed by the Labour Court is modified and the respondent-workman is held entitled to the amount of compensation as mentioned above. The amount of FDR which was created by the Registry shall be paid to the respondent-workman under proper receipt.

Disposed of in the above terms.

The pending miscellaneous application, if any, is also disposed of as such.
