The challenge in the present revision petition is to the impugned order dated 20.05.2019, passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, vide which the application to produce the original CD and material documents/record, filed by the prosecution, has been allowed.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, the petitioner has been convicted, vide judgment dated 06.10.2022 and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said fact. Even on the previous date of hearing, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to assist the Court.
