The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for release of the pensionary benefits for which, he is entitled for after attaining the age of superannuation on 31.07.2010 from the service of respondent-cooperative society.

It is not disputed that the respondent-Co-operative Societies comes under the supervision of Registrar Co-operative Societies, Punjab, Chandigarh. Keeping in view the fact that both the parties are disputing the facts and concededly, the pensionary benefits for which the petitioner is entitled for, have not been released to him, the Deputy Registrar Co-operative Societies, Sangrur is directed that both the parties be heard by the

said authority and all the record available with the petitioner as well as the respondents be summoned and thereafter, appropriate orders on the claim of the petitioner with regard to release of the pensionary benefits be passed by respondent No. 4.

For this, let the petitioner as well as respondent No. 4 appear before the Deputy Registrar Co-operative Societies, Sangrur on 02.04.2022. The authority concerned is directed to finalize the said proceedings within a period of six weeks thereafter, from 02.04.2022.

Petition is disposed of in above terms.
