Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the State to conduct fair investigation in FIR No.100 dated 26.06.2020 registered under Sections 306 and 34 IPC at Police Station Jamalpur, district Ludhiana.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that after the afore FIR was registered all the three accused were arrested. Thereafter, the State conducted a fair investigation and filed a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. before the Trial Court on the basis whereof charges have also been framed by the Trial Court against the accused persons under Section 306 and 34 IPC.

In the light of the afore statement, no further orders are required to be passed in the instant petition.
