Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that the petitioner was initially appointed as Science Master on Adhoc basis, thereafter, on 14.12.2002, he was appointed on the post of Headmaster by way of direct recruitment, but benefits of pay protection was not extended by the respondent department.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for grant of benefits as claimed in the writ petition, the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of serving a representation dated 09.02.2021 (Annexure P-2) upon them, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 09.02.2021 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the representation, respondent No. 3 is directed to decide the representation dated 09.02.2021 (Annexure P-2) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order. In case, after the decision of the claim of the petitioner, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for the monetary benefits, the same should also be paid to the petitioner within a period of four weeks thereafter.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
