ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were fully eligible for the post of Lower Division Clerk ('LDC' - for short), but the candidature of petitioner No. 1 was erroneously rejected. He also submits that petitioner No. 2 has secured more marks than the last selected candidate in his category.

Learned State counsel while referring to the written statement submits that petitioner No. 2 has been found eligible and meritorious for appointment to the post of LDC in the BC-A category and has been selected for the post and, therefore, petition *qua* petitioner No. 2 has been rendered infructuous.

The petition *qua* petitioner No. 2 stands disposed of as infructuous.

As far as petitioner No. 1 is concerned, he did not have 'O' level certificate in computer from a recognized institution. Therefore, I do not find

any merit in the claim of petitioner No. 1, as he did not have requisite computer certificate, which is the essential qualification for eligibility.

Consequently, the petition *qua* petitioner No. 1 stands dismissed.
