The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of the India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to immediately release the sanctioned capital subsidy/investment incentive to the petitioner company in terms of Sanction Letter dated 11.08.2020 (Annexure P-1) alongwith interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submitted at the outset that during the interregnum, the sanctioned capital subsidy/investment incentive already stands released in favour of the petitioner company. He further submits now the issue remains only with regard to award of interest on the delayed release of the subsidy in favour of the petitioner. Therefore, he seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present petition so as to enable him to move appropriate representation before the competent authority in accordance with law.

The prayer made by the counsel for the petitioner is not objected to by the learned State counsel.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.

Needless to mention that in the event the petitioner moves any such representation before the competent authority within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, prompt decision shall be taken by the respondent-authorities by passing a speaking and reasoned order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within a period of four months thereafter.
