Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.42 dated 25.05.2022, registered under Sections 323, 324, 447, 511 and 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on), at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka.

Vide order dated 29.07.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner had been granted *ad interim* pre-arrest bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 29.07.2022

granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
