The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for modifying the order dated 18.05.2022, passed by the Additional District Judge, Hoshiarpur (in short 'ADJ'), in CRR No. 89 of 2022, arising out of the complaint bearing No. 18 of 2011, vide which, no stay of trial proceedings has been ordered by the ADJ.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has contended that the trial qua the remaining accused is likely to conclude soon and that as the revision petition against the summoning of remaining 7 accused has not yet been finally decided, the same is likely to cause grave prejudice to him, inasmuch as, the said accused would not be subjected to the process of law. I am afraid that such a suggestion is not borne out of the statute or the statutory procedures. The apprehension is misconceived.

In view of above, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed.
