AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of the detenue-Jeyansh Singla (son of the petitioner) from illegal detention of in-laws of the petitioner.

Considering the sensitivity of the matter, the matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court but the mediation failed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to avail remedy under The Guardians and Wards Act, 1890. He submits that an interim application for visitation rights would be filed before the Court.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

In the eventuality of the petitioner filing an application for interim relief, there is no doubt considering the age of the child, the Court concerned will decide the same in accordance with law.
