This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 47 dated 25.2.2019, under Sections 302/323/324/148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No. 7, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

The petitioners were granted interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 11.9.2019 subject to joining investigation within two weeks.
