Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the prayer of the petitioner is covered by the judgment of this Court in *CWP No.1486 of 2018 titled as Kidar Nath Kohli and others versus State of Haryana and others, decided on 13.12.2018*. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is entitled for the benefit under the said judgment which is not being granted to her and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case, a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the claim of the petitioner keeping in view the judgment of *Kidar Nath Kohli's case (supra)*.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the case of the petitioner will be considered in terms of the judgment of this Court in *Kidar Nath Kohli's case (supra)* and appropriate order on the said claim will be

passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and in case, the petitioner is found entitled for the relief, the same will also be extended to the petitioner within a period of four weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
