The petitioner Amrik Chand @ Laddi has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing the FIR No.30 dated 05.02.2021, registered under Sections 323, 354, 506, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise between the parties (Annexure P-2) and all other subsequent proceedings.

The brief facts of the case are that complainant-Satya Devi, informed the police that Amrik Chand @ Laddi along with 20/25 unknown persons armed with sharp weapons and with muffled faces attacked them. They gave beatings to her elder son Pawan. He ran away and saved his life. They abused her and pushed her and raised lalkaras in the street. The residents of the street witnessed the occurrence, with these allegations the present FIR has been registered.

The petitioner filed this petition for the quashing of aforesaid FIR on the basis of compromise. The petitioner and respondent No.2 were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements on the basis of compromise. The detailed report regarding compromise has been received from the the court of Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Amritsar dated 26.08.2022. The statement of respondent No.2 and complainant- Satya Devi and Pawan Kumar have been recorded jointly, where they confirmed the compromise with the petitioner. They confirmed that this compromise has been effected without any pressure, coercion from any side and they have no objection regarding quashing of FIR.

The petitioner-Amrik Chand @Laddi also confirmed this fact in his separate statement. The statement of ASI Rajbir Singh is also recorded who further confirmed that the accused is not involved in any other case nor he has been declared as proclaimed offender.

Therefore, from the report of Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Amritsar, it is clear that the compromise has been effected between the parties without any pressure, coercion or unde influence, which is acceptable to both the parties. This compromise will bring peace and harmony in the society. No purpose would be served with the continuation of criminal proceedings.

Therefore considering these fact the petition filed by the petitioner is accepted and the FIR No.30 dated 05.02.2021, registered under Sections 323, 354, 506, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise between the parties (Annexure P-2) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
