On the previous date i.e. on 07.11.2022 the following order was
passed:-

“Petitioner No.1 in person submits that no orders are required to be passed in the present petition as both the petitioners have been issued Police Clearance Certificate on 27.10.2022. As such, the cause of action in the present petition does not survive.

It has also been pointed out that petitioner No.2 is the son of petitioner No.1 who is a major but the petitioner No.1 does not have the authority to withdraw the present petition on behalf of the said petitioner. It is further submitted that their counsel is in personal difficulty today. He seeks short accommodation as members of the Bar are abstaining from work.

On request, adjourned to 14.11.2022.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners affirms the aforesaid position and submits that both the petitioners seek withdrawal of the petition.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.4 affirms the aforesaid factum of Police Clearance Certificate having been issued to both the petitioners and does not object to withdrawal of the petition.
