[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 20.12.2021, in CRWP No.11947 of 2021 in case titled as '**Charnjit Kaur and another** versus **State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CRWP No.11947 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide representation dated 20.11.2021 by passing a speaking order within eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order, after hearing all persons, who were likely to be affected by the outcome of the said representation.

[3] Learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, has filed a short reply by way of affidavit of the respondent. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal of Orders (Annexures R-3 and R-4) states that in view of the representation of the petitioners having been decided in terms of (**Annexure P-1**), the petitioners do not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
