The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 08.02.2019 (Annexure P-19) passed by respondent No.1-The Registrar General of Societies Haryana as also orders passed by the Subordinate Authorities whereby elections of the petitioners was set aside and the Administrator had been appointed by the District Registrar, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the respondents contends that the tenure of the said cabinet had already come to an end and new cabinet body since then to be elected. The Administrator, thus, is no more Incharge of the Mayfield Garden Resident Welfare Society, Gurgaon. Therefore, no substance or relief is subsisting in this petition.

In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous at this stage. Liberty is, however, granted to the
