In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner worked with the respondents from 01.01.1983 till she attained the age of superannuation on 31.08.2020 but the services of the petitioner were not regularized by the respondents and that too without any valid justification though, the respondents have issued various regularization policies during the said period.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the order passed by a Division Bench of this Court in **LPA No.837 of 2018** titled as **Haryana Vidyut Parsaran Nigam Limited and others vs. Darshan Singh and others** decided on 19.07.2022, the prayer of the petitioner for the grant of regularization needs to be allowed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the

petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of serving a demand notice dated 17.07.2020 (Annexure P/8) upon the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction be issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said demand notice.

Learned State counsel raises no objection in deciding the demand notice dated 17.07.2020 (Annexure P/8) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in her demand notice, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the demand notice dated 17.07.2020 (Annexure P/8) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It is expected that while passing order, the order passed by the Division Bench of this Court in **LPA No.837 of 2018** titled as **Haryana Vidyut Parsaran Nigam Limited and others vs. Darshan Singh and others** decided on 19.07.2022 will be kept in mind by the respondents.

Present writ petition stands disposed off.
