The petitioner in the instant petition has sought anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in cross case bearing General Diary No.38 dated 19.07.2016, under Sections 323, 427, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 3 and 4 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 in FIR No.141 dated 14.07.2016, under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Shimlapuri, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 16.12.2021 as well as the previous order dated 08.09.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh, learned State counsel has not disputed the factual position rather stated to the effect that the petitioner is not required for any further custodial interrogation.

In the light of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
