Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.48 dated 20.03.2019, registered for offences under Sections 376 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Phase 1, Mohali (Annexure P-1).

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the petition. She, however, submits that as the petitioner, who was granted anticipatory bail, could not appear before the Trial Court, due to a communication gap, the petitioner will surrender before the Trial Court on 03.08.2022, the date fixed before the Trial Court. She has requested that a direction be issued to the Trial Court to decide the application for regular bail, which he intends to file on his surrender.

Request has been considered.

In case, the petitioner surrenders before the Trial Court on 03.08.2022 and joins the proceedings and simultaneously files an application seeking grant of regular bail, the Trial Court shall make an endeavour and decide it as expeditiously as possible.

Petition is disposed of.
