Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.7 to upload orders dated 24.04.2018 on the e-Courts Website in case bearing CNR No.PBJL030390742014 in case titled as “Jiwan Jassi Versus State etc.” and all other orders on daily basis as per report (Annexure P-3) furnished by the Chairman, Computer Committee, Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.4 contends that the grievance of the petitioner already stands redressed and that every earnest endeavour is being undertaken by the concerned

authorities to expeditiously upload the daily orders passed by the Court in each and every case. She, however, fairly concedes that there may be certain omissions but the said omission is purely an act of error or some negligence, however, the delay, in uploading of the said orders is being curtailed.

In view of the aforesaid stand, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not press the present civil writ petition at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed.

It is made clear that the recommendations made by the Chairman of the Computer Committee to upload the daily orders on the e-Courts Website shall be duly adhered to by the concerned Courts.

The instant civil writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
