The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of the summoning order dated 10.02.2022 (Annexure P-8) passed by JMIC, Hisar in Protest Petition No.1113 of 2017/2021 titled "Anupama Ahlawat Vs. Vikas Ahlawat and others" under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 506, 34 of IPC and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that by virtue of summoning order dated 10.02.2022, all 4 accused were summoned i.e. three of the petitioners and the 4th one was the husband namely, Vikas Ahlawat. He has submitted that husband Vikas Ahlawat has approached the Revisional Court wherein Revisional Court has set aside the impugned order. He submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition as the Revisional Court has already set aside the impugned order.

In view of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Learned Magistrate is to decide the case keeping in view the complete evidence available on record in accordance with law.
