The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.189 dated 12.11.2021 registered at Police Station Sidhwan bet, District Ludhiana (Rural), under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC.

Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Rajender Singh from the afore-said Police Station, apprises the Court that the petitioner has joined in the investigation in compliance of the order dated 29.07.2022 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench and is not required for his custodial interrogation and is also not involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature.

Keeping in view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of

interim bail, as extended to the petitioner by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 29.07.2022, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
