Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.39 dated 22.5.2017 registered under Sections 295-A, 341, 323, 506, 354 I.P.C, Section 3 of SC/ST Act and Section 66(A) of the I.T. Act, at Police Station Mattewal, District Amritsar now summoned vide order dated 25.7.2019 under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

By virtue of the order dated 10.9.2021, the petitioner was directed to appear before the Trial Court within 10 days and on his appearance he was directed to be admitted to interim bail.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 10.9.2021, the petitioner had appeared before the Trial Court within the stipulated period and had been released on interim bail.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner has already appeared before the Trial Court and has

joined the trial.

In view of the above, the order dated 10.9.2021, is made absolute and the petition stands allowed. The petitioner will continue to appear before the Trial Court during the trial.
