Petition herein,*inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 22.09.2020 (Annexure P-15) vide which petitioner was removed from service.

2. When the matter was called out for hearing on 06.05.2022, following order was passed:-

“On the asking of Court, learned State counsel seeks time to get instructions, to check in case petitioner can be accommodated against a vacant post, if available as on today. Since it does appear that she has been meted out with rather harsh treatment, for her absence of a few days from work due to reasons beyond her control, though it is contended by learned counsel for the respondent-State that she was absent without proper sanction.Adjourned to 01.06.2022.”

3. Learned State counsel has tendered a letter dated 30.05.2022 in course of hearing, which is taken on record and marked as Annexure ‘A’.

Apropos above, learned State counsel under instructions submits that post which was being earlier manned by the petitioner is stilllying vacant.

4. In the premise,writ petition is allowed to the extent that respondents shall consider the claim of the petitioner on the post in question subject to therebeing work requirement, she will be allowed to join duty unless, of course, regular appointment on the said post is contemplated then until the same is done.

5. Needful be done within a period of 30 days.
