Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though, the petitioner is discharging his duties but, he has not been paid salary by the respondents and that too without any valid justification. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled for salary, for the period, he discharged the duties. Prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the salary of the petitioner starting from 01.04.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 30.04.2022 (Annexure P/5), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 30.04.2022 (Annexure P/5) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in his representation, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 30.04.2022 (Annexure P/5) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to him within a period of next four weeks.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
