1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 04.09.2010 in CWP-13541-2020.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order Annexure P-1, the respondent has passed order Annexure P-3, which has been challenged by the petitioner by way of CWP No.16622 of 2021 and that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.
