The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.44 dated 14.4.2021 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station, Women Cell, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar.

By virtue of the order dated 7.9.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It is apparent that the matter was referred to the Mediation & Conciliation of this Court. The report of the Mediator has been placed on record affirming that the parties have settled their dispute amicably.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 7.9.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
