The petitioner has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.146 dated 29.07.2021 registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC.

Status-report filed on behalf of the respondent-State, by way of the affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dharamkot, District Moga, is already available on the file and the same is taken on the record.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Sirtaj Singh of the above-said Police Station, apprises the Court that in pursuance of the order dated 07.09.2021, the petitioner has joined in the

investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature.

Keeping in view the above-said submission as made by learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner vide the said order dated 07.09.2021, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
