[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 23.11.2021 in CWP No.20639 of 2021 in case titled as Om Devi and another vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the issuance of notice of motion on 01.08.2022, learned AAG has supplied copy of order dated 28.03.2022 passed by the respondent rejecting the claim of the petitioners and that in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 28.03.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[3] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
