Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.50 dated 17.05.2022, registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014, at Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar Rural.

Vide order dated 29.07.2022, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 29.07.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 29.07.2022 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
