Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.98 dated 10.7.2020 registered under Sections 323, 324, 427, 354, 382, 506, 307, 148, 149 IPC and sections 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station, Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka.

By virtue of the order dated 8.9.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 8.9.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the contentions raised by counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 8.9.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
