The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution for issuance of directions to respondent No.2, for releasing the petitioner on parole for a period of four weeks, for the repair of house.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the mother of the petitioner has moved a representation (Annexure P-1), sent through postal receipt dated 14.08.2021, seeking the requisite relief, which has not been decided yet and he would be satisfied if the said representation is ordered to be decided within a stipulated time.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of hearing, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Superintendent, District Jail, Karnal, to decide the representation (Annexure P-1), moved by the mother of the petitioner,

within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
