This revision petition has been filed under Article 227 Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 30.03.2022 (Annexure P-15) passed by Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Gurgaon, whereby the application moved by respondent No.1 (workman) under Rule XXIV of the Industrial Disputes (Central) Rules, 1957 read with Order XIX Rule 2 CPC was partly allowed and MW-6/Dilip Kumar was ordered to be recalled for further cross-examination.

Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has produced the copy of order dated 04.08.2022, passed by the Tribunal to submit that as it is observed that the effect of incomplete cross-examination of MW-6 Dilip Kumar would be considered at an appropriate stage, therefore, nothing survives for adjudication in this revision petition.
