This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the cross case of GD No.24 dated 03.08.2020 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 and 326 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Civil Line, Batala, District Batala of FIR No.286 dated 02.08.2020, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Civil Line Batala, District Batala (Annexure P-1) and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

On 01.08.2022, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court and get their statements recorded in support of the compromise and the trial Court was directed to submit its report. In pursuance of the said order, the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala has

submitted the report, as per which, in addition to respondents No.2 and 3, one Amritpal Singh, son of Harjit Singh, is also shown as a victim.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after impleading all the complaints/victims, including the said Amritpal Singh son of Harjit Singh, in the present case and after entering into compromise with all of them.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
