Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. a direction is sought to the State to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner with a further direction to the State to decide the representation filed by the petitioner dated 23.01.2019 (Annexure P-1).

A reading of the petition reveals that through the same the petitioner alleges harassment and threats to her life at the hands of her husband-respondent No.4 as also that respondent No.4 has thrown her belongings and the petitioner out of their matrimonial home.

In the affidavit filed on behalf of the State it has been submitted that after investigation of the matter the police found that on account of a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and respondent No.4 they had filed various cross complaints and that the complaints by the petitioner, including the grievousness raised through the instant petition,

were false and had been made only to seek possession of House No.260, Huda Colony, Sector 19, Panchkula.

In addition, learned State counsel submits that recently, on being contacted by the police, the petitioner had stated that she had no complaint against her husband.

In the light of the above stand taken by the State which remain uncontroverted as none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.
