The petitioner has assailed the order dated 18.07.2022 vide which interim maintenance has been awarded in favour of the respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matrimonial dispute has been amicably settled between the parties and lump-sum amount on account of permanent alimony has been paid to the respondent. As such, he has instructions to withdraw the present petition and has further prayed for refund of the amount of Rs.55,000/- deposited in the Registry on account of litigation expenses, as respondent has not appeared to contest the petition.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn and the amount of Rs.55,000/- deposited in the Registry be refunded to the petitioner.
