Learned State counsel has submitted the status report on behalf of the respondent-State by way of the affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, along with Annexure R-1, in the Court today and these documents are taken on the record.

However, at this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition while submitting that the petitioner would surrender before the concerned Court below within five days positively and he further prays that the said Court be directed to decide the bail application, as may be moved by him (petitioner) there, within some specific time frame.

Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn with a direction to the concerned Court below that in

case, the petitioner surrenders before it within the above-stipulated period and moves the application for seeking the relief of regular bail at the appropriate stage, the same may be decided within two days thereafter.
