The dispute is with regard to the payment of amount on account of compulsory acquisition of the land. The petitioners claim that the amount has not been completely paid. The Executing Court has dismissed the execution petition decree being fully satisfied.

It is evident from the reading of the impugned order that the State has claimed that the entire amount already stands paid. The petitioners have failed to convince the Executing Court as to how the decree has not been fully satisfied.

Learned counsel representing the petitioners contends that there is some error in calculating the amount.

If that is so, the petitioners are directed to file an application or file fresh execution petition, if maintainable, in accordance with law. If such an application is filed, the same shall be decided in accordance with law.
