The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0122 dated 6.4.2019 registered under Sections 363, 366, 376 IPC (sections 3, 4 of POCSO Act added later on) at Police Station, Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

By virtue of the order dated 2.8.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to appear before the learned Trial Court within 10 days from that day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 2.8.2022 petitioner had duly appeared before the learned Trial Court within the stipulated time period and he was admitted to interim bail. She submits that the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the fact that petitioner had duly appeared before the learned Trial Court within the stipulated time period and he was admitted to interim bail.

In view of the above, the order dated 2.8.2022 is made absolute. Petitioner is directed to appear continuously before the learned Trial Court as per its directions.
