Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No.233 dated 8.12.2018, registered under Section 498-A and 406 IPC, at Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to avail his remedy before the trial Court. He has further prayed that the petitioners are aged persons and as such their personal appearance before the trial Court may be exempted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

In case, the petitioners file an application for exemption from their personal appearance before the trial Court, the trial Court is directed to consider the same and grant exemption to the petitioners from their personal appearance during trial subject to their filing affidavit to the following effect:-

1. That they will have no objection if the statements of witnesses are recorded in their absence but in the presence of their counsel.
2. That they will appear before the trial Court as & when required to do so by it.
3. That they will abide by any other condition imposed by the trial Court while granting them exemption from personal appearance.
