The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial inquiry in case of unnatural death of son of petitioner namely Bhupinder Singh and to decide the representation dated 04.10.2021 (Annexure P-3) sent to respondent No.4 – the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur and representation dated 31.03.2022 (Annexure P-4) sent to the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Punjab.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the dead body of the son of the petitioner was recovered in village Makhu and that even though the petitioner approached the Senior

Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, however, he refused to take cognizance of the complaint submitted by the petitioner on the premise that area falls within the jurisdiction of SSP, Ferozepur. The petitioners have thereafter approached the SSP Ferozepur as well, however, on the issue of inter se jurisdictional dispute amongst the concerned SSPs, the representation/grievance espoused by the petitioner is not being examined. He further contends that he would be satisfied in case the representation submitted by the petitioner to SSP, Ferozepur which is appended with the present petition as Annexure P-3, is directed to be looked into and an appropriate action is taken thereupon as per law.

Notice of motion.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State has no objection to the same.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of with the consent of the parties, directing the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, to look into the issue of jurisdictional domain pertaining to the death of son of the petitioner and to take appropriate necessary steps in accordance with law.
