Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking quashing of FIR No.48 dated 13.03.2020 registered under Sections 342, 376, 452, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Utawar, District Palwal (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 01.06.2020 (Annexure P-2).

Status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Palwal, District Palwal, has been filed on behalf of respondent-State, which is taken on record.

Though State has verified the Marriage Certificate, Annexure P-3, yet in her statement, which is appended as Annexure R-1 with the

status report, the prosecutrix has stated that she is living with Isa (her first husband).

When confronted with the judgments of the Supreme Court in **State of Madhya Pradesh Vs. Laxmi Narayan and others 2019(2) RCR (Criminal) 255** and **Daxaben Vs. State of Gujarat and others 2022 SCC OnLine SC 936**, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to raise all the available pleas before the Trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
