For the reasons mentioned in the application and in view of no
objection given by the counsel for the petitioners, present applications are
allowed and the main case is preponed and taken up for hearing today itself.

Main Case

This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the
Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ, order or direction including
a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the part of impugned order

No.01/2022-PER-DTE-P2DA12-PER-DG dated 20.07.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.4, vide which the petitioner has been transferred to 53 BN Station at Baramulla in J&K, with certain other prayers made in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the transfer amendment order dated 08.08.2022 of the petitioner has been cancelled and the impugned order dated 20.07.2022 transferring the petitioner to 53 BN, CRPF stationed at Baramulla in J&K from Group Centre, Pinjore (Haryana) has also been cancelled and now the petitioner has been posted at 51 BN, CRPF stationed at Chandigarh. Therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the aforesaid factual position.

Dismissed as having been rendered as infructuous.

The pending miscellaneous application, if any, is also disposed of as such.
