JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure to direct the higher officer of the police department to initiate fair investigation in FIR No.136 dated 07.05.2022, under Sections 302, 34, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Narnaul, Mahendergarh.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the present FIR was lodged on 07.05.2022 and the police has not even taken any action in the present FIR and has not investigated the case properly and in a fair manner.

At this stage. Mr. Ranvir Singh Arya, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana has stated that the grievance of the petitioner

is totally misconceived. He further submitted that in the present case one accused has already been arrested and matter pertains to Section 302 IPC and the police has investigated the case in a fair and proper manner and there is no ground available with the petitioner to say as to how and in what manner the police has not investigated the case in a fair manner.

At this stage, Ms. Jaideep Kaur, learned counsel for the for the petitioner has stated that the remaining accused who have not been arrested are constantly threatening the petitioner and the information regarding the same was given to the police but no action has been taken by the police on this issue and his life is also in danger.

Mr. Ranvir Singh Arya, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana has stated that in view of the above he has no objection in case a direction is issued for the purpose of assessment of threat perception of the petitioner and in case it is so required, then appropriate steps will be taken in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid position, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Mahendergarh at Narnaul to assess the threat perception of the petitioner at the hands of the accused and in case it is so required, then it shall be ensured that no harm is caused to the life of the petitioner and further action shall be taken in accordance with law.
