This is a petition that has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to correct the date of birth of the petitioner to 01.07.1975 from 02.02.1965.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would contend that the actual date of birth of the petitioner is 01.07.1975, however, in his service record, it is mentioned as 02.02.1965. It is only when he inspected the service record, he came to know that his date of birth has been mentioned incorrectly.

Faced with the judgment rendered in *Ambika Kaul Versus Central Board of Secondary Education and others, 2015(3) S.C.T. 350*, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not press the instant

petition, however, seeks liberty to approach the Civil Court for correction of his date of birth as mentioned in his service record.

After having heard counsel for the petitioner, the prayer made for withdrawal of the writ petition to approach the Civil Court is acceded to.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
