HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, the petitioner was wrongly shown as dead, whereas he is alive, and the benefits, for which he became entitled for upon his retirement in November, 2003, upon attaining the age of superannuation, have not been released in his favour by the respondents.

After notice of motion, the respondents have filed the reply as well as the additional affidavits, wherein it has been mentioned that the petitioner has already been extended all the benefits, for which he was found entitled for after his retirement, starting from December, 2003 till February, 2005, and therefore, no other benefits remain to be extended to him by the respondents as of now.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been

not pressed any further at this stage, but with a liberty to the petitioner that

in case any other grievance of the petitioner remains to be redressed, he may approach the respondents by way of filing an appropriate representation in this regard.

Learned State counsel very fairly submits that in case, any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be considered in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of such representation.

As prayed for by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of as having been not pressed any further with the liberty as prayed for.
