By this common order, both the aforementioned writ petitions
shall stand disposed of as both are having common facts and question of
law.

Prayer in petition bearing CWP No.16777 of 2020 is for
issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to remove from
black list Indica vista Car No.PB-65 AT-8112 registered in the name of the

petitioner and prayer in the second petition i.e. CWP No.25540 of 2021 is for issuance of writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing of impugned notice dated 20.11.2020 (Annexure P-2), with a further prayer to direct the respondents to pay compensation of Rs.5.00 Lakh for forcing petitioner in unnecessary litigation causing mental harassment, loss of reputation, financial loss etc.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the State has already filed the written statement in CWP No.16777 of 2020. He has further submitted that pursuant to the receipt of the complaint qua the car of the petitioner, the respondents-State had initiated an enquiry into this aspect. The petitioner, as well as, some other persons have already been issued notices to join the enquiry so as to dispose of the matters.

In view of the above, the present writ petitions are disposed of with a direction to the respondents-State to conclude the enquiry, if any, qua the vehicle of the petitioner; within a period of six months from today and to take further action in the matter accordingly.

CM-11667-CWP-2020 and CM-603-CWP-2021

In view of the fact that the present petition is disposed, the present applications for impleading the applicants as respondents are dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

All pending miscellaneous applications in both the petitions are also dismissed as such.
