The petitioner was issued passport in the year 2015 which allegedly recorded an incorrect date of birth. It was entered on the basis of documents as they existed then. Subsequently, the petitioner has got those documents corrected including the birth certificate and has applied for re-issuance of passport with corrected particulars. The original passport has been cancelled but fresh passport has not been issued till date.

Learned counsel for the petitioner was asked to inform the Court regarding the basis on which the petitioner realized that the date of birth as recorded in the original birth certificate was wrong but no satisfactory answer was given. Thus, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforementioned liberty.
