Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that in the present case, the question of law as raised, has already been answered by the Division Bench of this Court while passing order in CWP No. 19641 of 2009 titled as ***R.K. Aggarwal and others Vs. State of Haryana and others***, decided on 21.12.2012 and hence, respondents are under obligation to

consider the claim of the petitioners keeping in view the decision in ***R.K.***

Aggarwal's case (supra), and grant the petitioner appropriate relief.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the petitioners keeping in view the judgment in *R.K. Aggarwal's case (supra)*, will be considered by the respondents within a period of eight weeks and appropriate order will be passed regarding the claim of the petitioners that they are similarly situated as *R.K. Aggarwal's case (supra)*, and are entitled for the same benefit as extended to the petitioners therein and in case the same is found genuine, the petitioners will also be released the benefit within a period of next four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed.

Ordered accordingly.
